





Think of this graph as showing the “speed” of the viral transmission measured in new cases/day.

In the “worst week” of our 2nd wave (Week 45: Nov 6-12, 2020), the new daily cases averaged 7 for that week).


For the weeks in January 2021,

Week 2: Avg. of 23 new cases per day


Week 3: Avg. of 30 new cases per day



6 of 25 press releases had no testing data...


Approximately 4,200 tests performed.

Average of 150 tests per day performed.




Northern Districts (Castries, Gros Islet, Babonneau) have 75% of local cases...
